**DOMESTIC SUPPORT OBLIGATIONS**

A "domestic support obligation" is defined broadly to include a debt that accrues before, on or after the date of the filing of your bankruptcy petition, including interest that accrues on that debt that is owed to or recoverable by a spouse, former spouse, or child of the debtor or such child's parent, legal guardian or responsible relative or governmental unit. See 11 U.S.C. § 101(14A).

A domestic support obligation is in the nature of alimony, maintenance or support (including assistance provided by governmental unit) of such spouse, or child of the debtor or such child's parent, without regard to whether such debt is expressly so designated. Such obligations are domestic support obligations whether they have been established or subject to establishment before, on, or after the date of your bankruptcy filing in accordance with a separation agreement, divorce decree, or property settlement agreement, a court order or a determination made by a governmental unit.

Any such obligation is not a "domestic support obligation" if it has been assigned to a nongovernmental entity, unless the obligation is assigned voluntarily by the spouse, former spouse, child of the debtor, or such child's parent, legal guardian, or responsible relative for the purpose of collecting the debt.
